Following the Christchurch Earthquakes, Patterson Contracting Otago Ltd. identified the considerable risk now involved in foundation replacement work. Patterson Contracting developed a building stabilisation system that provides the same seismic bracing value as the current building code, ensuring the safety of people working under the building. This system has been adopted by the construction industry for safe lifting practice in Christchurch.
